History / Purpose

The Beryle Gardner Award was established in 2005. It was designed to encourage individuals under the custody or supervision of the Vermont Department of Corrections to complete their high school diploma. Beryle Gardner believed that these individuals had the right to a basic education and the opportunity to improve their future. The recipients of this award will exemplify Beryle's appreciation of community service and education.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1) Any student who received or will receive a high school diploma from the Community High School of Vermont from July 1 through June 30 of the current academic year.
- 2) Any student earning at least one credit from CHSVT and earning a diploma from their district high school from July 1 through June 30.
- 3) Applicants may apply for multiple scholarships but will be eligible to receive only one award.

Awards

Three categories of \$300 scholarships each:

- 1) **Higher Learning** (*Post Secondary Education*)
- 2) **Trades** (*Manual or Mechanical Vocation or Occupation*)
- 3) **Living, Learning, Working** (*Support or Professional Development to a graduate entering the workforce*)

Application Criteria

- Essay
 - Briefly tell us about yourself
 - Why you want this award
 - Your future plans
 - Your history of Community/Volunteer service in or out of the facility.
- Recommendation letter
 - One from the education team at your campus
 - Community service reference
